Initial admission and eligibility to remain in the Academy are based on a portfolio of student, teacher, and parent information that may include, but is not limited to the following information: standardized test scores, teacher recommendations, grade point average, previous academic coursework, a personal essay, community involvement, parental approval and commitment to support.

The HAHST selection committee reserves the right to consider approval of applicants based on a variety of qualifications and accomplishments and on a case-by-case basis.

Students whose requests for open enrollment have been granted must provide copies of their most recent transcripts, attendance and discipline records, and CSAP results.
